Please have your student write on each of these prompts during your trip. Journal 1:

What is the main type of transportation you are taking to reach your destination? Write about your experience using this type of transportation. Was it comfortable? How long were you traveling?

Journal 2:

Talk about where you are staying - the outside and the inside. What are your thoughts and feeling about staying here?

Journal 3:

Who is with you on your trip and/or who are you visiting? What is the purpose of your trip?

Journal 4:

Talk about the types of food you are eating. Are they different than what you normally eat?

Journal 5:

Write about any interesting, memorable, or exciting places that you see or things you do. Give me details!

If you are gone for more than 5 days, keep journaling! You choose the topics.
